On May 15, 1953, the first Pinewood Derby was held by Cub Scout Pack 280C in Manhattan Beach, California. Pack 280C's Cubmaster, Don Murphy, invented the Pinewood Derby. By having his scouts and their dads make the car together, he felt this activity would foster a closer father-son relationship along with good sportsmanship through competition. Since then, over 100 million Pinewood Derby cars have been handmade and raced worldwide.
